



NOMINATIONS FOR CONSUMER AFFAIRS COUNCIL

The Minister for Justice and Attorney General Dr Peter Toyne is seeking nominations from members of the Northern Territory community wishing to be considered for appointment to the Consumer Affairs Council.

The Council, appointed under the *Consumer Affairs and Fair Trading Act* is an advisory body to the Minister responsible for Consumer Affairs. It is the function of the Council to represent the interests of Northern Territory consumers and provide advice to the Minister to reflect the needs and rights of Territory consumers.

Members will be appointed from a broad range of community sectors and from urban, regional and remote areas of the Territory.

Members are appointed for a three (3) year term.

Nominees should have experience of, expertise in and knowledge of the affairs of community/consumer and trade organisations, and be able to provide a consumer/user perspective.
